2026 KWVA Scholarship Program – SFC (Ret) David Pickett - Chairman

This Scholarship program consists of three \$1,500 non-renewable scholarships and five \$1,000 non-renewable scholarships. The funds may be used for any term during the next academic school year following receipt of the scholarship. Although this scholarship is not renewable, the applicant may reapply for the scholarship in subsequent years.

Please note that priority of the KWVA scholarships will be given to Korean War Veterans descendants, Korean Defense Veterans and descendants, U.S. Military Veterans and descendants.

Applicant Qualifications

- Must be a citizen of the United States.
- First Year Student applicants must have a Letter of Acceptance as a full-time student from their university.
- Must be pursuing an Associate, Bachelor, or Advanced Degree in any discipline.
- Must have a minimum 3.5 GPA stated on application must be verifiable from transcript.
- High school and college transcripts must be submitted and must have school names printed on them (do not send them separately).
- For high school students entering college, this is a cumulative GPA for grades 9-11 and first semester of 12th grade.
- For students currently at freshman level in college, it is the cumulative GPA for grades 9-12 and first semester of college.

Deadlines

All scholarship applications and requested materials must be submitted via US Postal Service and post marked between June 1 — June 30, 2026. Only parcels that are post marked between the stated dates will be accepted.

PLEASE NOTE: PARCELS REQUIRING A SIGNATURE WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED!

The Scholarship Committee will acknowledge receipt of your application providing you include a separate sheet of paper with your phone number or email address.

Only scholarship recipients will be notified. Checks will be mailed directly to the address provided on your application. All decisions made by the Scholarship Selection Committee will be final. Scholarship recipients will be announced at our Annual meeting in October and published in *The Greybeards* magazine.

Required Materials

The items listed below are required to complete the application and must be submitted in a single envelope, to be considered for a scholarship. Failure to follow these instructions will result in disqualification. Application must be filled out in its entirety. Proof of service for deceased Korean War relative. (if applicable)

Proof of service for Defense Veterans descendants. (if applicable) Proof of service for US Military descendants (if applicable). GPA — submit all applicable high school transcripts. First year student's Letter of Acceptance to college.

Sophomore college students please submit your high school transcripts as well as your college transcripts. Junior and Senior college students please include your transcript for all college semesters completed.
